1. Discussion/Possible Action on the Minutes of the Selma Regular Monthly City Council Meeting of April 13, 2023.

Councilman Kevin Hadas made a motion to approve the Minutes of the Selma City Council Meeting of April 13, 2023. Councilwoman Becky Harris seconded the motion. The motion was adopted by a 4-0 vote.

2. Discussion/Possible Action on the quarterly investment report for the period ending March 31, 2023.

Councilwoman Becky Harris made a motion to approve the quarterly investment report for the period ending March 31, 2023. Councilman Noah Washington Jr. seconded the motion. The motion was adopted by a 4-0 vote.

3. Presentation/Discussion by Ms. Monique Vernon, Director of Development Services, on a status update of various ongoing and upcoming city infrastructure and capital improvement projects.

Monique Vernon, Director of Development Services, provided the City Council with an update regarding various capital improvement projects. Ms. Vernon provided an update on the following: City Hall Heroes Memorial Plaza, with estimated completion by the end of May; the Lookout Road and Mount Crest traffic light installation, scheduled to begin May 15th; water site #4 access drive, located off Lookout Road, scheduled to begin May 15th; Retama Parkway reconstruction, from Lookout Road to H-35, will be bid ready by the end of June; Olympia Hills drainage channel reconstruction; 2022 city-wide street striping, which was completed the first week of May; a bid opening for the 2023 city-wide sidewalks project, scheduled for May 25th; the coordination phase for the reconstruction of Weiderstein Road, Bell Lane, and Ash Lane; lastly, bid documents preparations for pavement improvements in Retama Ridge and Retama Springs subdivisions; with an estimated bid opening date of June 1st. Council took no action since this was an informational update.

4. Presentation/Discussion by TRIPP Consulting on a potential city-subsidized rideshare program.

David Harris greeted the City Council and briefly summarized the program before introducing Scott Sellers, a Transit Ridesharing Inclusive Public-Private Partnership (TRIPP) consultant. Mr. Sellers explained the details of the rideshare proposal to the City Council. Council took no action since this was an informational presentation.


