**1. Public Hearing/Discussion/Possible Action on Ordinance Number 092123, an Ordinance by the City Council of the City of Selma, Texas adopting and levying the tax rate on all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City for the year 2023.**

The motion was adopted by a 4-0 vote.

Councilman Ken Polasek made a motion to ratify the property tax rate increase reflected in the 2023-2024 City of Selma Budget. Councilman Kevin Hadas seconded the motion. The motion was adopted by a 4-0 vote.
